Action for Children Step Out Walk 2025

Our support helps to give those who need it access to safe water, sanitation and hygiene. The six certificates from Tearfund are now displayed in the toilets - Gents, Ladies and Disabled.

Work is ongoing to repair and upgrade our sound system. We now have a lockable cabinet sited in the back pew, containing all the equipment, including CD player, necessary to make the improvements. The engineer will be returning to do more work on the organ amplification and also to install a new hearing loop system in Arthurs' Room.
