## 2. Care Givers Programme:

We have a high volume of people this year in these projects. They are eager to learn different skills and the attendance is very good. Trainers are happy with the numbers of people coming in.

### · Sewing

This group have 69 new members this year. They are trained in threading the machine, front aprons, girls school skirts, boys' shorts, graduation gowns, cushions and cushion cover, bags, pencil and peg bags. This term they've done girls schools skirts and cushions.



### Beadwork

The beadwork group have 45 members. They are taught on how to make ring earrings, necklaces ankle bands, book marks and a lot more.





# · Cooking and Baking

Different skills are taught in this group more especially in a way of healthy cooking, because that is what we promote to our gogo's and youth. The group have been taught on safety and hygiene, then trained on how to make different kinds of healthy food and bake as well.

We have good numbers in both Childminder and Edu-care and so far, everything is going well with the training.

Supervisor course block training in Hammarsdale went well and this group will be graduating along with Childminder on the  $19^{th}$  of June 2025.
